## Big Dog Bowl Registration and Check-In

Da List, Inc. – Big Dog Bowl is requiring all coaches, staff, and players to check-in no later than 5:00 PM on January 3, 2014 at John Muir High School.

Since there are 32 teams participating in the Big Dog Bowl, we recommend that all of the coaches, staff, and players arrive at John Muir High School by 4:00 PM.

All coaches must have their Red Line Roster, with no more than 6 blanks. All players must have an official form of identification that includes: (1) photo; (2) date of birth; (3) height; and (4) weight. All players are required to prove their identity on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. These rules are to ensure the safety of all players in the Big Dog Bowl and the rules will be strictly enforced.

The Opening Ceremony will commence at 6:00 PM and include an award presentation for those individuals that volunteered for Da List, Inc. – Big Dog Bowl.

There will also be former NFL Football players sharing their thoughts, comments, and encouragement to the coaches, staff, and players.
